



# GREENWAYS South Courtenay

Courtenay's popular network of Greenways is steadily growing. There are now over 23 kilometres of trails throughout the city.

South Courtenay's best known greenway is the Courtenay Riverway, which runs all the way from Mil-

lard Road to downtown Courtenay. It's not only one of the Comox Valley's most beautiful settings, with spectacular views of the Courtenay estuary, a variety of wildlife plus small planes landing at the Airpark - it's a great way to get around town without a car!

### Courtenay Riverway

- Spectacular views of Georgia Strait, the Comox Glacier, the Beaufort and coastal mountain ranges.
- Adjacent to the InfoCentre and public washrooms.
- 6.5 km trail: level and paved north of 31st St; asphalt, gravel and boardwalks south of 31st.

### Piercy Greenway

- New paved greenway accessible from Piercy Avenue and Willemar Avenue.

### Millard Creek Greenway

- 34 acres of natural park land.
- Entrance at Anfield Road and Old Island Highway.

### Proposed "Rail with Trail"

- Courtenay and Comox are exploring options for a greenway along the E & N corridor. Stay tuned for updates.
